

PVRI Annual Congress 2025 Abstract guidelines, terms & conditions

- Abstracts (in English) should be in Word or PDF format and with no more than 300 words. No figures or tables should be included.
- The names of all authors and affiliated institutions (in English) must be included (abstract title, authors and institutions are not included in the word count). Authors' names should be labelled with numbers to match with their affiliations please write the full affiliation for each author.
- All correspondence relating to abstracts will be undertaken by email with the first or senior author. It is their responsibility to communicate any relevant information regarding the submitted abstract and the Congress to the other authors.
- The best abstracts in the following areas will be selected for oral presentations in our main programme, so please indicate if your submission is relevant to one of these areas when you submit:

1. Establishing the framework for the classification & diagnosis of PH worldwide

- 2. Risk stratification & treatment in the new era of PH therapeutics
- 3. Vascular heterogeneity in chronic lung disease
- 4. Heterogeneity in PH associated with heart disease
- 5. The individual exposome & it's contribution to PH heterogeneity
- 6. Quantifying therapeutic responses
- 7. Leveraging disease heterogeneity in clinical trial design
- 8. None of the above
- The best abstracts will be considered for travel awards based on available funding.
- The accuracy of the submitted abstract is the responsibility of the authors. You should prepare and proofread your abstract carefully before submitting to ensure it is the final version.
- The text version of all accepted abstracts will be published in our journal, *Pulmonary Circulation*, and may appear on PVRI's website.
- There is no fee for abstract submission, but you must have an active PVRI membership to submit [link to membership page].
